



1 UNDERSTAND

- Genetic tumour risk syndrome (genturis): increased risk of developing tumours often in multiple organ systems.
- More than 40 different genturis.
- Cancer associated with genturis may need different treatment and follow-up.



2 DETECT

- Genetic diagnosis is key to identifying patients and relatives.
- Healthcare professionals should be trained to recognize hereditary cancer syndromes.



3 TREAT

- Multidisciplinary care involving e.g. geneticists, surgeons, oncologists is crucial for the best outcomes.
- Helping patients and families to cope with diagnosis and risk is essential.



4 RAISE AWARENESS

- Educating healthcare professionals leads to better patient outcomes.
- ERN GENTURIS registry and Patient Portal help to improve diagnostics, prevention and treatment.

5 FOLLOW UP

- Genetic testing of relatives is essential to provide preventive care options.
- Lifelong surveillance programs should be in place to ensure timely detection and intervention.
